



### Family Child Care Homes

Children are cared for in licensed homes located in the Gunter Annex and Maxwell housing areas. These providers are licensed through the Family Child Care Office. There are also affiliated providers in the local community who care for children. They are licensed through the state and the family child care office. Please call 953-2585 for more information.

### Part-Day Enrichment

A two-or-three day program is available for children, 3-5 years old. The program runs September through May. Classes are held from 8:30 to 11:30 a.m. with a morning snack. Children must be 3 and be fully potty trained.

### Before-& After-School Care

This program is for children who attend 4 year old kindergarten at the Maxwell Elementary School.



### Give Parents a Break

This program is for parents in stressful situations, offered in conjunction with the Air Force Aid Society for children, 6 months to 5 years of age. Referrals to this program are made through base agencies. For more information, contact either CDC.

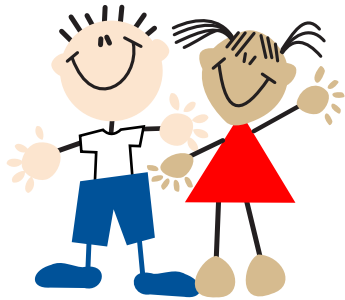

# Welcome

## Programs

The centers offer full-time and hourly care, whenever available, for the following age groups:

6 weeks-6 months (full-time care only)	Ratio: 1:4
6-12 months (full-time care only)	Ratio: 1:4
12-24 months	Ratio: 1:5
24-36 months	Ratio: 1:7
3-5 years	Ratio: 1:12



## Fees and Charges

Weekly fees are based on combined family income in accordance with the Military Child Care Act of 1989. Hourly fees for daytime care are \$3 per child. Hourly fees for nighttime care are \$4 per child.

## Registration

AF Form 1181, the Air Force Child Development Program Patron Registration Form, must be completed before admittance. Immunization records are required to ensure all immunizations are up to date.

## Hours of Operation

The CDC's are open from 6:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday-Friday. Special openings are available for weekend and evening care. Reservations for special openings must be made at least two weeks in advance with a minimum of 15 children. A deposit is required for special openings.



## Eligibility

Dependents of active duty, DOD civilians and contractors employed at Maxwell or Gunter Annex are eligible. Bona fide house guests may also use the centers.



## Meals and Snacks

The centers have been certified by the U.S. Department of Agriculture Child and Adult Care Food Program. Nutritious meals and snacks are approved by the base dietician and are served at no additional charge in accordance with Air Force guidelines.
